### WETLAND BUFFERS

are areas where vegetation binds soil with its roots to prevent erosion. They filter sediments, nutrients and harmful pollutants (such as phosphorus and nitrogen) acting like a filter that purifies the water. Buffers act like a giant sponge during heavy rainfall, thus reducing floods downstream and offering food, shelter and protection for wildlife. Please don't mow grasses, prune or clear vegetation surrounding the wetland or dump anything (dirt, grass clippings, yard or pet waste) within wetlands or buffers.
