

Newly Planted Boulevard Trees Need Your Help for a Successful Start!

To ensure the vitality of your new tree, please
follow these watering guidelines.

Trees planted in well-drained sites during the growing season in the Midwest require daily attention. At each watering, apply 1 to 1.5 gallons of water for each inch of trunk diameter. The length of the frequency of watering will vary according to the size of the trunk of the planting stock.

Less than 2-inch diameter—water daily for one week; every other day for 1-2 months; weekly until established.

2 to 4-inch diameter—water daily for 1-2 weeks; every other day for 2 months; weekly until established.

4-inch diameter—water daily for 1-2 weeks; every other day for 2 months; weekly until established.

Daily watering is not necessary when planting in the fall or early spring. Reduce the frequency of watering in cool, cloudy, wet weather if soil is poorly drained. Following a rainfall, wait until all free moisture drains out of the soil. Watering can cease once trees drop deciduous foliage in the fall. Establishment takes 12 months per-inch—trunk diameter.

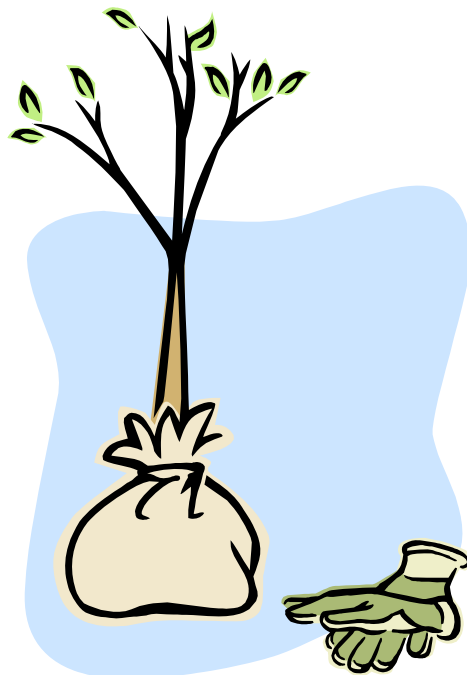
